TASTING NOTES

This wine offers an earthy, sophisticated nose of red currant and savoury plum layered with notes of herbs and white button mushroom. On the palate, it shows impressive fruit intensity and a firm tannic structure, delivering a long, ageable finish.



VINEYARD

Secret Mountain Vineyard,
Oliver

Altitude and constant breezes in our Secret Vineyard keep the final wine elegant and balanced, while also fostering an ideal environment for sustainable viticulture practices.

PAIRING

This wine is a natural match for earthy dishes like wild mushroom risotto or a classic herb-crusted rack of lamb. Its sophisticated edge makes it the perfect bottle to uncork for an intimate dinner party or a quiet evening by the fire.

Serve at 13-16°C



WINEMAKING

Grapes were hand-picked, then whole-berry fermented in stainless steel and neutral bins using a mix of targeted and ambient yeasts. The wine then underwent élevage in a combination of new French oak, neutral puncheons, and barrels before a coarse filtration.
